RESPONSE

IF ON SKIN: RINSE SKIN WITH WATER

IF INHALED: REMOVE PERSON TO FRESH AIR AND SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION IF STILL FEELING UNWELL.

IF IN EYES: RINSE CAUTIOUSLY WITH WATER FOR SEVERAL MINUTES. REMOVE CONTACT LENSES IF PRESENT AND EASY TO DO. CONTINUE RINISG IF EYE IRRATION PERSISTS SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION.
